Admissions FAQs

What is your admission criteria?

Generally, students accepted to Ursuline tend to score in the top 70th percentile of the TACHS; however, additional selection criteria may be considered to help determine acceptance and placement of students who may fall outside of that range.

How much is tuition?

Tuition for the 2020-2021 school year is \$19,725.

Do you award scholarships?

Merit-based scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen. Students who achieve 90th percentile or above in the Local Achievement Score on the TACHS or ISEE entrance exam will be offered scholarships. Eligible students can also take our Scholarship exam in November to earn additional awards.

A select number of privately-funded scholarships are available each year for incoming and rising 9th graders. The separate applications are accessible on our website.

Do you offer financial aid?

Yes, families must submit a financial aid application, which can be accessed on our website. Annual aid grants are based on demonstrated need and individual family circumstances.

What is your average class size?

Our average class size is 19 students. Some classes have fewer than 10.

How many sports do you have? How many clubs?

We have 35 separate teams representing 13 sports. On average, we offer over 60 student-run co-curricular clubs each year.

What are my transportation options?

Do you offer an honors program?

Ursuline offers college prep, honors, and AP level courses.

Do you offer Advanced Placement classes?

Ursuline currently offers 17 AP courses: Art & Design 2D, Art & Design Drawing, Biology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Computer Science A, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Environmental Science, European History, Italian Language & Culture, Latin, Macroeconomics, Physics 1, Spanish Language & Culture, US Government & Politics, and US History.

Students can also earn college credit in select courses via St. John's University's Advantage Program.

Who are the Ursulines?

St. Angela Merici founded the company of St. Ursula in 1535, in Brescia, Italy. The Ursuline Sisters' primary focus became education and their work spread around the world. The Ursuline School is one of a network of secondary schools and colleges of the Ursuline Sisters across the United States, and 36 countries on 6 continents.

What are your Signature Programs?

Our 3 year Science Research Program offers enhanced study in the fields of science and collaboration with a mentor. The Global Scholars Program augments the classroom education by providing a global perspective, Global Scholars earn a special distinction upon graduation.
